



2. Fill in the password field (normally it is a combination of lower case and upper case letters, a non-alphabetic character and some numbers. I.e. UPPIo_9999)
3. Push “Login” button.

If the password is correct you should enter in the platform and, the upper right of the main page it will indicate that you have successfully logged in.



FOLLOW A LESSON


After logging in enter in the course (Parents, Teachers, Professionals) by clicking the name or the icon.



To activate the zoom hold the CTRL key on your keyboard and turn the wheel of your mouse towards you to zoom out (smaller image to fit the screen) and in the opposite verse to zoom in.

In Apple computers, touch screens and tablets you may obtain the same effect by moving two fingers farther apart or closer together while touching the display (pinch-to-zoom gesture). In notebook the mouse wheel is simulated by the right side of the touchpad.
